Program Description:

The program will begin in Paris but will be primarily hosted in the city of Cherbourg where an infrastructure is in place to provide all services to the students. Cherbourg is in the heart of Normandy on a peninsula that reaches into the English Channel.

Program Focus:

Trips to cultural sites will also convey important information about both contemporary and historical France.
