Program: THE NETHERLANDS

Approximate Program Dates: Mid June – Mid July

Program Focus:

This program is designed to provide students with a variety of courses while they experience Dutch culture first hand. Trips to cultural sites will also convey important information about both contemporary and historical Netherlands. Course proposals are welcome from all academic fields, as long as they relate closely to The Netherlands.

Program Description:

This month long program takes place in Amsterdam, Noordwijk, and Rotterdam. The Dutch enjoy a rich cultural history and students will see much of it in museum visits, on excursions and in daily life in Holland. Excursions may include trips to world class museums, art and graphic design studios, and important historical monuments. Individual instructors will arrange local excursions related to their classes.
