

Program Description for Prospective Faculty

Program: ENGLAND

Approximate Program Dates: Three weeks in June (subject to change)

Program Focus:

The focus for this program is theater and the literature of the theater. Course proposals should relate to this focus and utilize the experience of being in London. Students will attend 6-8 theater performances while in London, and the experience of the theater should be incorporated into all courses. In the past, courses in acting, literature and theater appreciation have been offered. Courses not in these areas will be considered on a case by case basis.

Program Description:

London, England is the location for this program. It is a cultural center not only for the United Kingdom and the former British Empire, but also for the entire world. London is teeming with theaters, museums, and monuments, as well as restaurants and ethnic neighborhoods which represent virtually all of the cultures of the world.

Students will survey and study various topics of drama as it relates to the theatre and everyday life.
