

2018 TnCIS Study Abroad Scholarship Application

We are pleased that you are interested in applying for a scholarship for the Tennessee Consortium for International Studies (TnCIS) study abroad program through Nashville State Community College. This application is only for students who are currently enrolled at NSCC. Scholarship amounts will be awarded at approximately 50% of the cost of the program fee (program cost information available on the TnCIS website www.tncis.org). The cost of tuition for the course is paid by NSCC.

Students who are eligible for the NSCC Study Abroad Scholarship must:

- Have completed online TnCIS study abroad application
- Have completed 12 college-level credit hours at NSCC by January 2018 with a minimum GPA of 2.0
- Be currently enrolled and maintain enrollment at NSCC through the spring 2018 semester
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0
- Have successfully completed, at the time of application, Learning Support Reading,
 Learning Support Writing, and Learning Support Math; this applies only if learning support courses are required
- Be a degree-seeking student

 In about 500 words, tell us about your personal goals and interests and why you are a good candidate for <u>studying abroad and for the scholarship.</u>

TnCIS EARLY ACCEPTANCE:

16 November 2017 Submit NSCC Scholarship Application and TnCIS Application due by 4:30 p.m.

3 December 2017 Non-refundable application fee of \$100 due for early acceptance (pay at Bursar's Office)

TnCIS REGULAR ACCEPTANCE:

6 February 2018 Submit NSCC Scholarship Application and TnClS Application due by 4:30 p.m.

11 February 2018 Non-refundable application fee of \$100 due for regular acceptance (pay at Bursar's office)

08 March 2018 Full program payment due

PLEASE NOTE: It is recommended that you apply early as programs may be filled to capacity prior to the Regular Acceptance Deadline. Additionally NSCC study abroad scholarships are limited and are awarded using a competitive process. It is possible that all scholarships will be awarded by the Early Acceptance dates and scholarships will not be available for the Regular Acceptance date. Scholarship applicants may be required to participate in an interview as part of the selection process. NSCC will notify scholarship applicants via the official MyNSCC student email address prior to the deadline for the application fee. Awardees who withdraw from the TnCIS program are responsible for all program costs due at the time of withdrawal from the program and will not be eligible for the scholarship. Scholarship is dependent on student meeting all TnCIS payment and document deadlines.
