Beginning Spanish II: SPAN 1020

Prerequisites: SPAN 1010; Entry Level Standards: Completion of transitional studies English and reading courses.

This course is a continuation of Beginning Spanish I. It will concentrate on Spanish conversation, grammar, composition, vocabulary building and reading. Excursions could include trips to Madrid and visits to El Prado Museum, Centro de Arte Reina Sofia, Museo Thyssen- Bornemisza, Palacio Real, and the Plaza Mayor. Additional excursions could include El Escorial and the Valley of the Fallen, Salamanca, Avila, Segovia, Alcazar, and Catedral. All excursions will encourage students to use their Spanish.

Intermediate Spanish I: SPAN 2010

Prerequisites: SPAN 1020

This course will concentrate on Conversation, writing, listening and reading. The emphasis will be on communicative proficiency. Spanish Conversation: SPAN 2510

Prerequisites: SPAN 2020 or 4 years of high school Spanish or equivalent in life experience. Entry Level Standards: Intermediate level competency in comprehension, speaking, reading and writing Spanish.

This course will focus on the functional aspects of speaking Spanish to increase proficiency through sustained, topic-related conversations, with grammar and conceptual review.

Excursions could include trips to Madrid and visits to El Prado Museum, Centro de Arte Reina Sofia, Thyssen-Bornemisza Museum, Palacio Real, and the Plaza Mayor. Additional excursions could include: El Escorial and the Valley of the Fallen, Salamanca, Avila, Segovia, Alcazar, and Cathedral. All excursions will encourage students to use their Spanish.
